Halton Hills: Last night was a chance for Georgetown residents to hear from the Halton Catholic District School Board Trustee candidates at Christ The King High School on Highway 7. Board supporters were hoping to hear the candidates views on some of the issues concerning the Catholic District School Board. Unfortunately, incumbent trustee candidate, Irene McCauley, didn't show up for the scheduled all candidates meet. The parent council Vice Chair dismissed the taxpaying audience without giving McCauley's opponent, Rosanna Palmieri, any opportunity to handout flyers or address the audience.

Mayor Candidate Robert Heaton attended the meeting hoping to raise or address concerns of the unparallel growth that's been going on in Halton Hills, which has resulted in portable classrooms littering the parking lot of the brand new high school. The Mayor Candidate was told to stop handing out his campaign literature too, which directly addresses the portable classroom issue.

Silver Creek: The Mayor Candidate Robert Heaton was also seen at the Silver Creek Public School - Public Meeting hosted by the Halton District School Board. The public meeting was to discuss the Board's plans to bring an entire portable school to Georgetown south called, a Porta-Pak. The reason given by the Halton District School Board representative for not building a new school, was because Halton Region sewage capacity was not reserved for any new school. However, the Region continues to hand out allocations to developers building new subdivisions, such as approved Sheridan Nursery project in Glen Williams.

Visibly absent from both meetings was Mayor Rick Bonnette.
