Halton Region's Bureaucracy set to grow, with your tax dollars

Halton Hills: This week Halton Region moved forward with its plans to create an Energy From Waste (EFW) Facility when it issued a Request For Proposal (RFP) to five consulting firms, as chosen through an Expression of Interest process. The successful firm will work with staff on developing a business case to present to Regional Council in the spring of 2007.

The business case will include the preliminary air quality, environmental, health, transportation and financial assessments needed to initiate public consultation and make an informed decision on the options for Halton's EFW facility.

Halton Region announced its plans to investigate Energy From Waste in the summer, extending the \$100 million investment Halton taxpayers made in the siting, assessment and building of the Halton Waste Management Site.
