Chudleigh, mudding Caledonia's waters while supporting peace antagonist

Chudleigh, mudding Caledonia's waters while supporting peace antagonist.

Halton: Recently, we received a letter to the editor complaining about how Ted Chudleigh, MPP for Halton was involving himself in an issue in another MPP's riding. Chudleigh recently criticized in a newspaper article, the McGuinty Liberal's for their diplomatic efforts in addressing the Caledonia clash. Chudleigh also appeared to be praising Gary McHale who was not only breaking the law, but antagonizing a potentially violent, dangerous, politically sensitive crisis.

A resident from Richmond Hill, Gary and Christine McHale asserts on their [e-blogger](#) that they've been married for the last 25 years, claiming they both work from home doing web site design. McHale admits, both he and his wife are both members of Chudleigh's Conservative Party.

The [OACP](#) (Ontario Coalition Against Poverty) calls McHale actions; **"Racism Out of Control"**

They wrote; "Garry McHale is a wannabe martyr whose racist demonstrating only serves to help fuel the fires of a small group of wing-nut, racist locals. He and other malicious, hateful outsiders are imported to inflame the situation, likely with the intent to cause violence. McHale and others went back to the Site not long after they failed to put up Canadian flags and the OPP told them they couldn't do it so close to Six Nations' territory.

McHale was outraged when he was arrested. He was charged with breach of peace, which he says isn't a charge and isn't in the criminal code. It is. Breach of peace is the law that the cops use to pick up drunks and toss them in the drunk tank for the night."

McHale reacted by publishing pictures on his ["Caledonia wake-up call" website](#) of the peace officers who have refrained him from imposing his will, identifying them as anti-Canadian's. The website also [edited pictures](#) of some of the officers adding ballooned phrases from the mouths of the officers in an attempt to make them look ridiculous.

In the press release published December 26, 2006 in the Georgetown Independent, Chudleigh criticized Ontario's governing Liberals in an article titled; **"McGuinty breaks promise to Caledonia"**. But Chudleigh failed to remind the papers readership how the Harris Conservatives mishandled the fatal [Ipperwash clash](#) that ended up costing a protester his life and the province of Ontario, millions upon millions of dollars and continues to do so. An investigative inquiry is currently underway where allegations of intolerance and impatience at the highest levels surfaced many times. But the biggest bombshell came from former attorney general Charles Harnick in November 2005. [Harnick testified](#) that former conservative premier Mike Harris said; "I want the f***** Indians out of the park". Dudley George was killed by OPP officers at Ipperwash Provincial Park while protesting for native land claims and protecting the destruction of their (native) burial grounds.

This is the letter The Halton Herald received from the concerned community member who requested it published in response to Chudleigh's critical letter concerning Caledonia:

This was Outside Agitator Gary McHale's 2nd attempt to disrupt the peace in proceeding once again with his plans despite the objections voiced by the residents of Caledonia and Six Nations. These concerns are supported by the Six Nations Elected Chief, the Six Nations Confederacy, the OPP, municipal officials, and politicians at the federal, provincial & municipal levels.

[McHale's website](#) reveals the inflammatory intentions. While McHale claims to be interested in the "Rule of Law", he clearly wants to disrupt the fragile peace of the community.

Claiming to have 20,000 supporters, McHale planned to lead this group directly onto the Douglas Creek Estates site.

As Elected Chief David General has stated repeatedly, "send your prayers ... not your people". "Pray for Peace" - & please, do NOT attend with Gary McHale.

Various media covered the events; there is no need for any additional spectators.

Thanking you in advance for your prompt attention to this request."

While Chudleigh is quick to jump to the aid of a peace antagonist in another ridding, a man who many are calling a "racist out of control", a man who defames our Provincial Police Officers who are ordered to perform a task, Chudleigh has still failed to jumped to the aid of a number of members in his own ridding, constituent's such as Derrick Williams who are currently being politically targeted and persecuted beyond the confines of our courts, behind closed municipal doors by the local government where Chudleigh resides and supposedly, represents.
