Halton - Halton Hills: Terry Alyman is in contradiction of the Town's - "Personnel Policy" - 'using Town services for personal use'.

According to the Town's "Employee Personnel Policy- Manual ADMIN-2004-0031",

Terry Alyman utilizing the Town's solicitor for personal services contradicts Schedule 'H' in the Employee Personnel Policy Manual ADMIN-2004-0031.

Under Code of Conduct: Section 'F' - Municipal Resource section:

Quote:

Elected officials, citizen appointees and **staff** shall not utilize the Town's purchasing activities for the acquisition of personal goods or **services**.

The Ontario Superior Court ruled last Friday, April 7, 2006;

"Governments are accountable to the people through the ballot box, and not to judges and juries in courts of law.

When government is criticized, its recourse is in the public domain, not the courts. The government may not imprison, or fine, or sue, those who criticize it. The government may respond. This is fundamental.

Litigation is a form of force, and the government must not silence its critics by force."

Contradicting the Town's own "Personnel Policy", Halton Hills Town CAO -Dennis Perlin LLP, informed Mr. Kirouac in a meeting on April 10th, 2006, despite the Judges decision to strike the Town's claim and his reasons for doing so, The Town of Halton Hills will be using taxpayers money to finance Town's Director -Terry Alyman's personal claim against Al Kirouac.

On April 12, 2006, Al Kirouac contacted The Town of Halton Hills CAO Dennis Perlin, stating;

"Mr. Perlin,

As a follow-up to our meeting of April 10, 2006, regarding being informed, by yourself, of the Town's intentions to finance Terry Alyman's personal civil matter against myself.

This was forwarded to me today:

"Terry Alyman utilizing the Town's solicitor for personal services contradicts Schedule 'H' in the Employee Personnel Policy Manual: ADMIN-2004-0031.

Under Code of Conduct: Section 'F' - Municipal Resource section:

Elected officials, citizen appointees and staff shall not utilize the Town's purchasing activities for the acquisition of personal goods or services."

Apparently, any agreement to let Terry Alyman to continue using taxpayer funded Town services, for his own personal use, contradicts the policy set out in the Employee Personnel Policy Manual: ADMIN-2004-0031.

This e-mail serves as notice and documents my contentions. Furthermore, I demand any continued infringement or abuse of said policy, cease forthwith. Please advise."

Mr Perling responded April 13, 2006;

"Thank-you for your E-Mail.I will look into this and get back to you."
